
I spoke with Auditor, Tracey Rash above captioned and I would propose an amendment to Section 1 Bill No. 36-2010 Ordinance No. 2010-49 passed by City Council on December 21, 2010 as follows:

For the construction of an EMS facility and acquisition of a fire pumper, the sum of seventy-five hundreds (.75) mills on each dollar of assessed value [or the sum of seven and five tenths (7.50) cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation]; The sum of seventy-five hundreds (.75) mills on each dollar of assessed value (or the sum of seven and five tenths (7.50) cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation] shall be placed in a separate bank account, separated and segregated from all other monies, entitled, EMS Facility/Fire Pumper and shall not be co-mingled with any other monies whatsoever. All disbursements from this EMS Facility/Fire Pumper account shall be subject to City Council approval prior to disbursement to assure these funds are utilized for the construction of an EMS facility and acquisition of a fire pumper only. (Emphasis supplied.)

Query: Should Article 121.08(d) be modified as well? (Gaming Local Share Account)

Given the contents of this memorandum, it is my suggestion that this communication be read at the appropriate City Council Meeting and referred to City Committee for review.
