



The City of Bethlehem is committed to ensuring fairness when it comes to housing for its residents. In addition to abiding by Title VIII of the Civil rights Act of 1968 (Fair Housing Act), as amended, the City affords additional protections by prohibiting housing discrimination based on actual or perceived race, color, sex, religion, ancestry, genetic information, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, familial status, marital status, age, mental or physical disability, use of guide or support animals and/or mechanical aids.
