## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q. What is a StoryWalk?**

**A. A StoryWalk is a fun, interactive educational activity that places the pages from a children's story along a popular walking route in the community.**

**Q. Where will the StoryWalks be displayed?**

**A. The StoryWalks will be displayed at five areas throughout Bethlehem: Bethlehem Area Public Library, Greenway, Sand Island, Elmwood Park, and the Rose Garden.**

**Q. When does the StoryWalk program begin?**

**A. The program begins on June 19, 2017. A total of five stories will be displayed at each designated park throughout the summer.**

**Q. How long will each story be displayed?**

**A. Each story will be displayed for two weeks.**

**Q. How do I track the stories that my child reads?**

**A. Each StoryWalk will have a box that contains a tracking card and a stamp. Simply stamp the card when your child reads a story.**

**Q. How does my child receive a free book?**

**A. If your child reads all five stories, they are eligible to receive a free book. You can pick up the book at the Bethlehem Area Public Library (Main and Southside branches).**
