



## 2016 Special Event Fee Schedule

### Code Enforcement

1. Each tent over 1600 sq. ft. or a combination of tents over 1600 sq. ft. \$50.00 (plus \$4 state fee)
2. Each Structure (trailer, stage, etc.) \$50.00 (plus \$4 state fee)
3. Electrical feeds \$75.00 (plus \$4 state fee)

### Electrical

1. Manpower—Electrician—Regular time is \$49.42 and OT is \$60.52 (per person/hr)
2. Aerial Boom Truck \$65.00 (per vehicle/hr)
3. Pick-up Truck \$20.00 (per vehicle/hr)

### EMS

1. Paramedic Crew (2 person) & Ambulance \$95.00/hr

### Engineering

1. **Street Banner/Pole Banner**
  - a. \$100.00 per banner/location \$40.00 per banner/location
2. **Right-of-Way:**
  - a. Sidewalk Sale: \$25.00
  - b. Special Event (i.e. Musikfest) \$100.00 per permit/location
  - c. Non-Vending Activities \$100.00 per permit/location

### Fire

1. Bon Fire/Open Burn \$54.00
2. Fireworks Display \$54.00 per display
3. Open Flame Public Performance \$54.00
4. Fire Roster - \$58.09/man/hour

### Health

1. One day temporary Health License \$26.00
2. Two/three day temporary Health License \$41.00
3. Four days or more temporary Health License \$76.00

### Legal

1. Use Permit \$50.00 (required for events lasting longer than 3 consecutive days or any event that includes alcohol)

## **Police**

1. Roster Rate \$50.00 per officer/hr
2. Overtime \$65.00 per officer/hr
3. Holiday Rate \$100.00 per officer/hr
4. Traffic Assignments \$69.00 per officer/hr (2 hour minimum)
5. Cruiser Car \$25 per vehicle/hr

\*NOTE: Must submit request for officer(s) 30 days prior to event. Invoice will be sent at the end of the event.

\*NOTE: Please provide a detailed clean-up plan (i.e. name the person(s) responsible to clean-up at the end of the event to pick-up any garbage and/or items on the sidewalk, in the street or elsewhere on public property. Areas not cleaned are subject to additional manpower fees as called out above (overtime is for an event that requires the Streets Bureau to come out during non-work hours to assist with clean-up).

## **Tax**

1. Business Privilege License \$25.00 (vendors must report gross earnings)

## **Traffic Maintenance**

2. Regular Time Manpower \$39.74 per person/hr (typically two technicians)
3. Overtime Manpower \$48.66 per person/hr (typically two technicians)
4. ¾ Ton Truck \$20.00 per vehicle/hr

\*NOTE: Invoices to be sent after event. Above is a sample of rates you will incur for set-up and takedown and/or any damage. Regular time manpower is for the set-up and removal of barricades, cones, and signage prior to (and after) an event during the normal working hours (7a-3p). Overtime manpower is for an event, race, or parade that requires technicians to come out during the event to assist with cone patterns, barricades set-up, etc.

## Water

1. Hydrant use fee \$49.58 per hydrant
2. Consumption charge \$3.333 per 1000 gallons of water used

\*NOTE: Only persons authorized by the City shall take water from any fire hydrant and no fire hydrants shall be used for any other purpose, except with the written approval and consent of the City. Any person who in any other way willfully causes damage to any equipment in the system or who uses water for which the City is not properly compensated shall be considered in violation of Ordinance 911 and shall be subject to the penalty set forth in section 911.99. No one will be permitted to access a hydrant when temperatures are at or below the freezing point.
